From April to August 2025, the animals are traveling a 20,000 km route, symbolizing their flight from climate disaster.

THE HERDS will come body to body, hoof to arm, horns to head with dancers from Sadler's Wells as they journey through East London. Featuring specially commissioned choreography by Associate Artist Alesandra Seutin, dancers try to stop the animals in every possible way.
