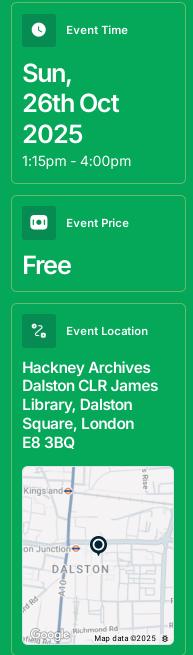
Join us to learn how to create content on Wikipedia, a free-content online encyclopedia written and maintained by a community of volunteers.
