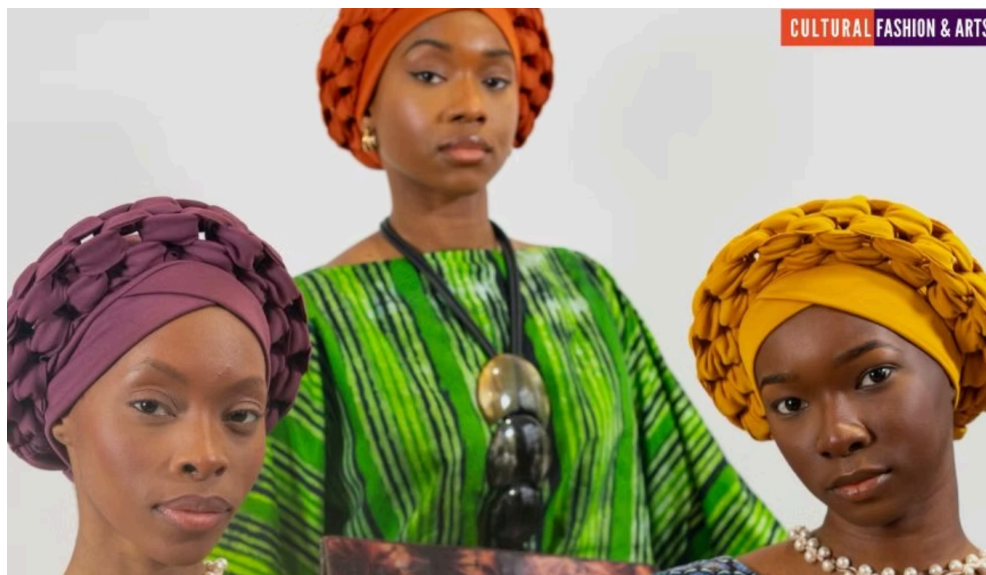


# Wrap and Roll: African Headwrap Workshop

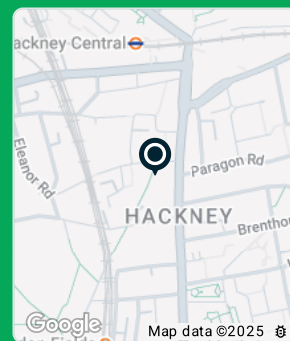
